



## Other Funding Types

**Healthcare Charitable Contributions.** To be eligible to apply for a healthcare charitable contribution, the organization must be a 501(c)(3) tax-exempt organization. The request for support should directly address patient education (including health screening), patient advocacy for disease awareness, or improving patient access to care (affordability, e.g., transportation costs).
